Subject: Response to Complaint Regarding EVM Battery Levels During Counting Process.

In continuation of Letter No. 1793 dated 18.10.2024 by this office, with reference to your complaint dated 9th October, 2024, concerning the Haryana Legislative Assembly General Elections - 2024, in which concerns were raised regarding the battery levels of the Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) at booth numbers 133 and 149, particularly the observation that the EVM battery levels showed 99% on the day of counting. It has been alleged that such battery levels are unlikely, implying a potential discrepancy in the process. It was also submitted in the complaint that in booth number 1 and 2, the candidate has been shown to secure similar number of votes. All the concerns have been comprehensively addressed in this letter and a detailed explanation has been provided based on facts, procedures, and the Election Commission of India (ECI) guidelines.

The election process begins six months prior to the general election. First, the First Level Check (FLC) of the Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) is conducted. Accordingly, the undersigned remains continuously active until the election is concluded. It would not be inappropriate to say that a Returning Officer works continuously and tirelessly, adhering to the standards laid down by the Commission, while being on duty 24 hours a day as per its guidelines. The presence of the Returning Officer during all procedures is not only mandatory but also ensures the smooth running of the process. All the duties as a Returning Officer throughout the various stages of the election have been diligently and faithfully performed. A brief overview of the entire process in relation to the complaint has been provided.

The administrative safeguards defined in the Commission's instructions and guidelines, combined with the technological security features, make the Electronic Voting Machines tamper-proof and completely free from manipulation. The Commission has prepared a checklist for each aspect of EVM handling after the election results are declared, which includes the transportation of machines from the manufacturer and the storage of the Electronic Voting Machines. Additionally, dos and don'ts have been specified to address any potential issues at various stages of the election.

The Election Commission has implemented a detailed and strict administrative system of protective measures and procedural checks and balances to ensure that Electronic Voting Machines are safe from any form of misuse, unauthorized access, or inadvertent procedural errors, whether before, during, or after voting, during storage or transportation. These security measures are applied transparently at every stage with the active and well-documented participation of political parties, candidates, and their representatives to build trust in the integrity and reliability of Electronic Voting Machines. These functions and procedures are carried out under the supervision, direction, and control of the Election Commission by District Election Officers, Returning Officers, or senior district officials, which you are well aware of. The involvement of political party agents in the process is so robust that no change in the EVMs or their transportation from one place to another is possible without the participation of political representatives. The main points of this process are reiterated for your information below:

1. First Level Check (FLC)

- According to the instructions of the Commission, included in the EVM Manual (August 2023), letter no. 51/8/16/9/2017-EMS (P&L) dated 09.11.2017, the detailed First Level Check (FLC) of both components of EVMs and VVPATs is carried out at least 180 days before the election in the state. The purpose of FLC is to ensure the authenticity and suitability of the EVMs and VVPATs to be used in the elections. The FLC is conducted at the district level under the supervision of the District Election Officer (DEO) in a fully secured and protected environment, in the presence of representatives of recognized political parties, by engineers from the manufacturing company. The DEO prepares a detailed schedule for the FLC and shares it in writing with each recognized political party at the district level, at least two days before the commencement of the schedule, under suitable acknowledgment, and copies



it to the state headquarters of the party. Political party representatives are requested to be present during the FLC. If they fail to participate in the FLC, a reminder is sent with acknowledgment. A register is maintained to obtain the signatures of the political party representatives who attend the FLC.

- The First Level Check (FLC) is a diagnostic test for each Ballot Unit (BU), Control Unit (CU), and VVPAT to verify the full functionality of the machines, as mandated by the manufacturer. After the inspection, the manufacturer issues a proper certificate stating that all the components of the EVM are original.
- The FLC is conducted in a large hall with 24x7 CCTV coverage and under full security with the presence of armed police forces, as per the detailed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) provided by BEL/ECIL. A logbook is maintained at every entry and exit point to record the details of each person entering the premises. The entire FLC process is supervised through webcasting at the DEO and CEO level control rooms (strong rooms) and reports are submitted to the Commission.
- As mentioned above, political parties are actively involved in every stage of the FLC to their full satisfaction. They are allowed to randomly select any machine and conduct mock polling themselves.
- After the FLC, the machines are sealed with pink paper seals. Political party representatives also sign the pink paper seal.
- For district Panchkula, the FLC was conducted at the district headquarters from 01.08.2024 till 09.08.2024. The following political party representatives participated in the FLC during these mentioned dates:

2. Post-FLC Storage

- The Commission has issued detailed instructions for the storage of "FLC OK EVMs" in strong rooms and for their 24x7 security. At least one section of the State Armed Police Force is deployed to maintain 24x7 security at the strong rooms.
- The entry point of such strong rooms and corridors are under 24x7 CCTV coverage with a DVR.
- A logbook is maintained by the security personnel stationed at the entry point.
- District Election Officer (DEO), Superintendent of Police (SP), Observers, and political party representatives visit the strong rooms.
- This arrangement continues until the first randomization of the Electronic Voting Machines is conducted for election preparation.
- Political parties are well informed about the storage and security of "FLC OK EVMs."
- For Panchkula district, the strong rooms for the "FLC OK EVMs" were established at **Administrative Block-cum-Multi Level Parking at 3rd Floor, Room No. 55-56.**

3. Randomization of Electronic Voting Machines

The Electronic Voting Machines stored in the strong room are randomized twice through the EVM Management System (EMS), an app developed by the Election Commission of India's IT team.

a. First Randomization

- Before the first randomization of Electronic Voting Machines, 10% of the machines are set aside for training and awareness programs, marked as "training and awareness." The District Election Officer then schedules the first randomization and sends a written invitation to all



recognized political parties in the state, with acknowledgment, at least 48 hours in advance.

- The first randomization is conducted through EMS in the presence of political party representatives to allocate machines to constituencies/segments randomly.
- A list of the randomized Electronic Voting Machines is provided to the political parties, and their acknowledgment is taken in writing.
- In Panchkula district, the first randomization was conducted on 02.09.2024 in the presence of representatives of various political parties:

- The Electronic Voting Machines allocated to my constituency were stored in the designated Assembly Constituency strong room at **Govt. P.G. College for Women, Sector-14, Panchkula.**
- The entire storage process was conducted under videography
- As prescribed in the Commission's instructions, appropriate arrangements were made for security and CCTV coverage.

b. Second Randomization

- After the finalization of candidates, the Returning Officer conducts the second randomization through EMS.



- This randomization is conducted in the presence of the representatives of recognized political parties and the Commission's observers, who are officers from All India Services from other states.
- Political parties are informed in writing about the schedule of the second randomization.
- Second randomization of Electronic Voting Machines was conducted on 24-09-2024 at 02.00 PM Conference Hall, Mini Secretariat, Sector-1, Panchkula in the presence of political parties:

4. Commissioning of Electronic Voting Machines

- After the withdrawal of nominations, the Returning Officer (RO) prepares the schedule for the commissioning of Electronic Voting Machines and the setting of candidates.
- All candidates are informed of the schedule with proper acknowledgment, requesting them to participate in the commissioning process.
- Candidates are requested to participate in the mock polling process.
- The commissioning of machines for the Assembly Constituency is done in a secured environment in a separate hall with full security coverage and 24x7 CCTV surveillance.
- The commissioning process is conducted by Assistant Returning Officers (AROs) and other officials deployed by the RO, with the assistance of the BEL/ECIL technical team, in the presence of the RO, the Commission's Observer, and all candidates present in the hall.

- To bring more transparency, separate TV monitors are installed at each Symbol Loading Unit (SLU) to display the symbols being loaded for the candidates and their representatives.
- At this stage, the engineers of the manufacturing company check all the components of the machine again, and after showing them to the candidates, they issue certificates to the Returning Officers.
- First, the Ballot Unit (BU) is prepared and sealed, then the VVPAT unit is prepared. A new power pack (battery) and a new paper roll are installed. After sealing the VVPAT compartment, the Control Unit (CU) is prepared and the candidates are set in it. A completely new power pack is installed in the CU.
- After preparing all three units (BU, CU and VVPAT) and replacing the old battery with a new one, the cables of the CU, BU and VVPAT are connected, and mock polling is conducted to ensure the proper functioning of the EVM and VVPAT.
- After completing the entire process, the machine is switched off, and the VVPAT and CU are sealed. The battery sections of the VVPAT and CU are also sealed using thread seals and address tags.
- The Returning Officer and the candidates or their representatives/agents sign all the seals of the EVM and VVPAT.
- After commissioning, the machines were stored again in the strong room with all protocols specified by the Commission.
- The commissioning and storage of the Electronic Voting Machines for my Assembly Constituency 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency was conducted from **25-09-2024** to **29-09-2024** at **Govt. P.G. College for Women, Sector-14, Panchkula**, in the presence of the candidates/representatives of the following political parties:

5. Dispersal of Electronic Voting Machines

- The Commission's instructions also provide that the Returning Officer will inform the candidates in writing about the date and time of opening the strong room during the departure of polling teams.
- In the presence of the Returning Officer, the Commission's Observer, and the candidates or their agents, the Presiding Officers of the polling teams thoroughly check that the Ballot Units, Control Units, and VVPATs are duly sealed, and their seals and address tags are intact, and the batteries have been installed.
- The candidates witness the departure of the polling parties along with the security personnel.
- If the polling parties halt at any intermediate location with the Electronic Voting Machines before or after voting, a suitable government building is designated as the intermediate EVM strong room.
- The same Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) is followed for the security, opening, or closing of the intermediate EVM strong room as is applied for the regular strong rooms at the Assembly Constituency headquarters.
- The movement of polling teams and vehicles carrying Electronic Voting Machines is monitored through GPS and mobile-based tracking systems at the DEO and CEO levels in the state.
- The DEO notifies all candidates and observers with details of the sector officers and the registration numbers and details of all vehicles transporting the Electronic Voting Machines.
- The Observer deputed by the Commission to the constituency monitors strict compliance with the instructions issued by the Commission in this regard.



6. Arrangements for Polling Day

- The Commission has laid down a detailed procedure for handling EVMs at polling stations on the day of polling, as well as the protective measures to be undertaken by the Presiding Officer and polling personnel, through its instructions no. 51/8/Inst./2023-EMS, dated 16.10.2023.
- Before the commencement of actual polling, a mock poll is conducted by the Presiding Officer in the presence of the polling agents of the candidates, following the procedure outlined in the Commission's instructions no. 51/8/7/2019-EMS, dated 30.09.2019.
- During the mock poll, at least 50 votes are cast, ensuring that votes are recorded for each candidate, including NOTA.
- After confirming the results of the mock poll, the VVPAT slips are printed, and the mock poll data is deleted, and the Control Unit and VVPAT are duly sealed again.
- The entire mock poll process is shown to the polling agents, and their signatures are taken. They are also allowed to sign on the paper seals. The Presiding Officer issues a mock poll certificate with the date and time of the mock poll.
- The Presiding Officer also notes the date and time of the commencement of actual polling in the mock poll certificate and the Presiding Officer's diary.
- The Commission has issued guidelines to polling personnel for dealing with contingencies during actual polling.
- In case the Control Unit shows a "low battery" indication, the power pack of the Control Unit or VVPAT, whichever is the case, is immediately replaced as per the instructions contained in the Commission's letter no. 51/8/7/2020-EMS, dated 25.08.2020.
- The Sector Officer, along with the engineer from the manufacturing company, is available in the field to assist in such situations.
- The Sector Officer is allocated reserve machines, and where necessary, the machines are replaced.

- If any machine is replaced, the entire process of mock polling and sealing is repeated on the new machine. The polling agents are allowed to sign the seals.
- After the completion of polling, the Presiding Officer presses the 'Close' button on the Control Unit to close the machine. The total number of votes recorded in the EVM is noted in Form 17C, and the date and time of the closing of polling are noted in the Presiding Officer's diary.
- The details recorded in Form 17C are shared with the polling agents present at the time of the closing of polling.
- The Presiding Officer then disconnects the Ballot Unit, Control Unit, and VVPAT, and places the Ballot Unit and Control Unit in their respective carrying cases.
- The Presiding Officer removes the power pack (battery) from the VVPAT and then seals the EVM and VVPAT in the presence of the polling agents at the polling station.
- The Presiding Officer signs the address tag and gets it signed by the polling agents.
- The sealed Electronic Voting Machines are transported to the collection centre under the security of the armed police force.

7. Storage of Used EVMs

- Separate strong rooms are designated by the Returning Officer in advance for the storage of used EVMs and reserved/failed EVMs.
- The used Electronic Voting Machines are stored securely under proper videography after informing the candidates and their agents in advance, following the instructions contained in the Commission's letter no. 464/Strong Room/2023-EPS, dated 18.07.2023.



- In the strong room for used EVMs, floor space is designated to stack the Electronic Voting Machines for specific polling stations in respective sections/racks.
- The Commission has laid down strict protective and security measures for the storage of used Electronic Voting Machines, which include the following:
 - i. A single point of entry into the strong room without any windows or alternative doors.
 - ii. The strong room, where used EVMs are stored, is secured with a double-lock system. The keys to Lock-1 are with the Returning Officer, while the keys to Lock-2 are with the Assistant Returning Officer.
 - iii. A two-tier security arrangement, with the innermost perimeter under CAPF coverage and the outer perimeter under the State Armed Police Force.
 - iv. CCTV cameras with DVR and uninterrupted power supply are ensured for the protection and security of the strong room.
 - v. A proper logbook is maintained by CAPF for every entry and exit, as well as the duty roster of security personnel. The logbook records the date, time, duration, and name of every individual crossing the inner perimeter, with signatures taken in each case. This includes visits by the Observer, District Election Officer (DEO), Superintendent of Police (SP), candidates, or their agents, or any other individuals.
 - vi. No vehicles, including those of any office-bearers or ministers or any other political office-bearers, are allowed to enter the secured premises where Electronic Voting Machines, VVPAT, and election papers are stored.
 - vii. Continuous videography of the entrance point is conducted while opening and closing the strong room in the presence of candidates or their representatives.



viii. Candidates can deploy their representatives outside the inner perimeter to monitor the security arrangements of the strong room.

- In 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency, the used Electronic Voting Machines were stored in the strong room at **Govt. P.G. College for Women, Sector-14, Panchkula** (location) on 06.10.2024 at 01:10 A.M. in the presence of the Observer Sh. K. Mahesh, IAS (**G-29316**) and the candidates/representatives of the following political parties:

- The entire process was duly videographed, and the signatures of the candidates/their agents were also taken in the logbook. They were allowed to deploy their representatives to monitor the security of the strong room.

8. Scrutiny of Form 17A and Other Documents

- On the designated day for the scrutiny of Form 17A and other documents, the District Election Officer/Returning Officer opens the strong room containing the election forms under videography in the presence of the Observer and the candidates/their election agents/their authorized representatives.
- If the relevant accompanying documents for the scrutiny of Form 17A need to be transported, they are transported under appropriate police escort with the Executive Magistrate. Candidates and their representatives are also allowed to follow the vehicle transporting such documents.
- Candidates/their election agents or representatives are properly informed about the travel plan.
- After the scrutiny of Form 17A and other documents is completed, they are repacked in their respective packets, and the strong room is closed and sealed after making an entry in the logbook and taking the signatures of all the

candidates or their representatives present, the Observer, and the Returning Officer.

- The entire process of opening and closing the strong room containing Form 17C and other documents is duly videographed.
- In 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency, the scrutiny process was conducted on 06-10-2024 on 11:00 AM at **Auditorium, PWD Rest House, Sector-1, Panchkula** in the presence of the Observer **Sh. K. Mahesh, IAS (G-29316)** and the candidates/representatives of the following political parties:

9. Counting of Votes

- On the day of counting, the strong room containing used Electronic Voting Machines are opened under videography in the presence of the candidates/their authorized representatives, the Election Commission Observer, and the RO/ARO.
- The preparation for transporting the used Electronic Voting Machines from the strong room to the counting hall is done safely along secured paths. Care is taken to ensure that the movement paths of EVMs from two strong rooms do not overlap. The movement of used Electronic Voting Machines is also videographed.
- Only the Control Unit (CU) are brought to the counting hall.
- Before switching on the Control Unit, the seals are thoroughly inspected by the counting staff in the presence of the candidates' counting agents.
- The votes recorded in the Control Unit are matched with the total number of votes mentioned in Form 17C, which was already shared with the candidates' polling agents at the polling stations.

- The start and end date and time of polling recorded on the Control Unit are verified and shown to the polling agents.
- The counting agents certifies by signing Form 17C that the Control Unit being used was the same one used at that polling station.
- After the counting of a particular machine/booth is over, Form 17C Part II filled by the Counting Supervisor is also tallied and duly signed by the Counting Agents of all candidates/political parties present of that particular booth.
- The Commission has issued clear instructions to deal with various contingencies arising from procedural lapses by the polling staff or discrepancies in the polling date and time details.
- After completing each round of counting, the Returning Officer announces the result of that round. At the end of the last round of vote counting on Electronic Voting Machines, the Returning Officer will conduct a mandatory verification of the VVPAT slips from 5 randomly selected polling stations for each Assembly Constituency.
- These 5 Electronic Voting Machines are randomly selected by the RO through the drawing of lots as per the procedure laid down by the Commission in its instructions no. 51/8/VVPAT-Instructions/2019-EMPS, dated 15.04.2019.
- The candidates are informed in advance about the draw of lots.
- In case of any discrepancy between the votes recorded in the EVM and the VVPAT paper slip count, the VVPAT paper slip prevails as per Rule 56(D)(4)(b) of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961.
- The entire process of EVM counting and mandatory VVPAT paper slip counting is videographed.
- The Observer remains present throughout the counting process from the start until the results are declared.
- In 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency, the counting process was completed at Auditorium, Govt. PG College for Women, Sector 14, Panchkula on 08.10.2024 in the presence of the Counting Observer Sh. Amit Kumar, SCS 1996 (S-35612) and the candidates/their counting/election agents. The polling stations that

were randomly selected for mandatory VVPAT slip counting were polling station 216, 217, 199, 128 and 211.

From the above, it is evident that political parties and contesting candidates/their agents were involved in various stages of the election process. Each of the Commission's instructions was strictly followed, and candidates/representatives were informed of these processes in a timely manner. The candidate/representative from INC participated in various stages, and the various stages of the election were implemented before them, the details of which are reiterated below:

- I. The schedule for FLC was shared in writing by the District Election Officer of Panchkula through letter no. Election-2024/4024 dated 29.07.2024 (**Annexure-VIII**), requesting recognized political parties, including the Indian National Congress (INC), to send their representatives to be present during this process. The INC representative Sh. Ravinder Rawal (District Coordinator INC) duly acknowledged the receipt of the program.
- II. The FLC of the Electronic Voting Machines was conducted in Panchkula from 01.08.2024 till 09.08.2024 at Administrative Block-cum-Multi Level Parking at 3rd Floor, Room No. 55, and during the process, 8 representatives were present on different dates from 01.08.2024 till 09.08.2024.
- III. The schedule for the first randomization of the Electronic Voting Machines was shared in writing by the District Election Officer, Panchkula through letter no. Election-2024/4783-88 dated 29.08.2024 (**Annexure-IX**), requesting all recognized political parties, including the Indian National Congress (INC), to send their representatives to be present during the first randomization process. The INC representative Sh. Ravinder Rawal (District Coordinator INC) duly acknowledged the receipt of the program. The list post-randomisation was given to the representatives of political parties and receiving has been taken (**Annexure-X**).
- IV. The INC representative Sh. Ravinder Rawal (District Coordinator INC) was present during the first randomization process. This process was completed to the satisfaction of all political representatives, and no objection or issue was raised by any party, including the INC.
- V. The schedule for the second randomization of Electronic Voting Machines for the 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency was shared in writing by me, as the Returning Officer, through letter no. 836-42/V.S. Elect.-24 dated 22.09.2024 (**Annexure XI**), requesting all contesting candidates, including the INC candidate Sh. Pardeep Chaudhary, to be



present during the second randomization process. You/your representative duly acknowledged the receipt of the program.

- VI. Again, regarding 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency, the commissioning of Electronic Voting Machines was conducted from 25.09.2024 onwards at Govt. PG College for Women, Sector 14, Panchkula. The schedule for this was shared in writing by me through letter no. 920-26/V.S. Elect. Dated 24.09.2024 (**Annexure-XII**) and letter no. VS/Election-2024/936-42 dated 24.09.2024 (**Annexure-XIII, Pages 1-3**), requesting all candidates, including the INC, to inspect the process and participate in the mock polling. Receipt of the schedule was duly acknowledged by candidate/representative.
- VII. You/your representative Sh. Devi Dayal was present during the commissioning process. No issue was raised by you/your representative during the commissioning. This process was completed to the satisfaction of all candidates/their representatives in my presence. After the commissioning process was completed, the Electronic Voting Machines were sealed with my signature and your signature/your representative's signature.
- VIII. Additionally, through my letter no. 1439-45/V.S./Elect.-2024 dated 03-10-2024 (**Annexure XIV**), you were informed in writing about the schedule for opening the strong room on the day of dispersal of the Electronic Voting Machines and polling parties (04.10.2024). You/your representative have duly acknowledged the receipt of the letter.
- IX. All the seals on the Ballot Units (BU) and Control Units (CU) were intact, and at that time, no issue or concern was raised by you/your representative regarding the safety and security of the Electronic Voting Machines.
- X. On polling day, a mock poll was conducted in the presence of your representatives at all polling stations of the 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency before the actual polling commenced. Your polling agents also signed the mock poll certificate, and no issue was raised by your polling agents regarding the mock poll process or the functioning of the Electronic Voting Machines.
- XI. The actual polling process was conducted smoothly, and no objections were raised by your polling agents at any polling station during the polling process.
- XII. After the actual polling was completed, the Electronic Voting Machines were sealed by the respective Presiding Officers in the presence of your polling agents, and at that time as well, no complaint or issue was received from you/your representatives regarding the polling process and the functioning of the EVMs.



- XIII. The used Electronic Voting Machines were deposited at the designated locations by the polling parties, and you were informed well in advance about this. According to the log register of the strong room, the used Electronic Voting Machines were stored in the strong room in your presence/in the presence of your representative Sh. Amandeep Chaudhary and the General Observer Sh. K. Mahesh, IAS (G-29316) on 06.10.2024 at 01:10 A.M (**Annexure XV**), and the strong room was sealed in their presence.
Further, the process of Scrutiny was also conducted on next day of poll i.e. 06.10.2024 in the presence of your candidate/representative Sh. Akshay Chaudhary and the General Observer Sh. K. Mahesh, IAS (G-29316) (**Annexure XVI**).
- XIV. From the date the strong room was sealed on 06.10.2024 until the date of counting on 08.10.2024, the used Electronic Voting Machines remained in the strong room, which was under the security of the Central Armed Police Force (CAPF) and the State Police. Strict protocols were followed for the movement of authorized personnel, and the log register entries show that you yourself visited the strong room on 06.10.2024 and monitored the movement in and out of the strong room regularly. Neither you nor your representatives raised any issue or complaint with me or any ARO during this period.
- XV. On the designated day of counting, the strong room containing the used Electronic Voting Machines was opened on 08.10.2024 at 07:45 A.M. You/your representative Sh. Amandeep Chaudhary and the Counting Observer Sh. Amit Kumar, SCS 1996 (S-35612) were also present during the opening of the strong room (**Annexure XVII**). The log register was signed, and the entire process was videographed. At that time as well, no concerns were raised by you/your representative regarding the safety and security of the used Electronic Voting Machines in the strong room.
- XVI. Furthermore, the counting agents nominated by you were present in the counting hall during the counting process. No objections were raised by your candidate/representative during this process.
- XVII. Apart from these opportunities, I have also held meetings with representatives of all political parties, including the Indian National Congress, from time to time and shared appropriate information with them. The attendance of the presence of your party's candidate/representatives are attached herewith (**Annexure XVIII**)
- XVIII. Furthermore, the list of all randomized Electronic Voting Machines was shared by the DEO with all recognized national and state political parties at both the national and state levels during the First Level Check. At each stage, you or your representative were present during the movement of Electronic Voting Machines from the strong room.

Moreover, following the order of the Honorable Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 434 of 2023, dated 26.04.2024, the Election Commission of India has prescribed administrative Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for the extraction of units for examination, protocol, and safeguards for the post-counting scrutiny and verification of the burnt memory/microcontroller of EVM units (Ballot Unit, Control Unit, and VVPAT) in its instructions no. 51/8/Instructions/2024-EMS, dated 01.06.2024. As per the time frame provided in paragraph 3(c) of those instructions, eligible candidates may submit a written request to the DEO within seven (7) days of the declaration of results. No such request from the INC candidate contesting from 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency was received.

Clarification on 99% Battery Level Display

As far as the question of the Control Unit displaying the battery status as 99% is concerned, it is informed that the batteries in the Control Unit are inserted and sealed in the presence of the candidates during commissioning, and their signatures are taken. These signatures can be checked by the candidate or their authorized representative at any stage, making tampering impossible. Alkaline batteries are used in the Control Unit of EVMs. This battery is capable of handling up to 2000 votes even when four Ballot Units are connected to the Control Unit, and it is a high-quality battery. The initial voltage of a new power pack is around 7.4 to 8.0 volts, and its power consumption is minimal. When the voltage is above 7.4, the battery capacity is displayed as 99%. With use, the battery capacity and resulting voltage decrease. As soon as the voltage drops below 7.4, the actual available capacity of the battery is displayed below 98%. The Control Unit remains operational as long as the battery voltage is above 5.8 volts. The percentage displayed depends on the initial voltage of the new power pack, mock poll, actual poll, and the use of the Control Unit, which may vary across different polling stations' EVMs.

It is reiterated that Electronic Voting Machines are stored under strict protocol and are under continuous security cover by the Central Armed Police Force (CAPF), police, etc. You/your authorized agent, along with representatives of other political parties, were involved in every stage of EVM handling, from sealing the battery section to storing the EVMs back in the strong room, taking them out on polling day, conducting polling, pressing the 'Close' button at the end of polling, sharing voting details with polling agents during the



day, sealing the EVMs after polling, transporting them to the strong room, sealing the strong room, opening it on counting day, bringing the EVMs to the counting hall, verifying the seals before counting, matching the votes recorded in Form 17C with the votes cast on the EVM during each round of counting, announcing round-wise results, and conducting the entire process transparently.

Also, Form 17C was shared with the polling agents, and the votes recorded on the EVMs were tallied with it during counting. At no point during this process were any objections received.

In addition, Sh. K. Mahesh, IAS (G-29316), was appointed as the General Observer, Sh. Ravi Shankar Chhabi, IPS 2007 (P-28729) as the Police Observer, and Sh. Darsi Suman Ratnam, IRS, as the Expenditure Observer in my Assembly Constituency 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency. The contact numbers of all these officials were shared with all candidates. All processes were carried out under the supervision of the Observers. At no point did your candidates/agents raise any objections with the Observers.

As the Returning Officer of 01-Kalka Assembly Constituency, the relevant instructions of the Commission were thoroughly studied. As per the Commission's guidelines, political parties and candidates were regularly communicated and provided with written information on each stage, with proper acknowledgments. Whenever an issue was raised by candidates or their representatives, Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer immediately resolved it following the existing provisions and the Commission's instructions. Upon factual investigation of all the points raised in your complaint, it has been found that all your allegations are baseless and without merit. It is reiterated here that – from the First Level Check (FLC), the first phase of randomization, the second phase of randomization, the commissioning of EVMs five to seven days before the election, signing of the address tag after inserting the battery, storing the machines in the strong room, distributing the commissioned Electronic Voting Machines from the distribution center to the polling parties, reaching the polling stations with the polling parties, conducting mock polling before the actual polling, voting throughout the day, pressing the 'Close' button after polling, providing details of the votes cast to the polling agent during polling, sealing the EVMs after polling and signing the seals by the polling agents, transporting the EVMs to the strong room and storing them in the strong room, sealing the strong room, opening the strong room on the

day of counting, bringing the EVMs to the counting hall, verifying the seals on the EVMs before counting, matching the votes recorded on Form 17C with the EVM votes during each round of counting, announcing the round-wise results – you or your appointed representatives have been continuously present at all these stages. In addition, all these processes were continuously monitored by the Central Observers, Sector Officers, and were covered under videography/CCTV coverage/log books/entries in registers. Therefore, tampering, manipulation, or alteration of Electronic Voting Machines is entirely impossible. Thus, the allegations made by you appear to be unfounded, baseless, and motivated by an afterthought and seem to be intended to create a false narrative.

Despite this, if you are not satisfied with the response given by me, you have the option to challenge the election through an election petition before the competent High Court under the provisions of Section 80 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

Hope this clarifies all the concerns.
