Please find enclosed herewith a copy of Commission's letter No. 576/14/2024/EPB dated 31st August, 2024, copy of communication received from the Chief Electoral Officer, Haryana letter No. 131(27)/Dry Day/HVS/Elec-2024/2AE-8823 dated 02.09.2024, on the subject cited above, for information and necessary action. As you are aware that Election Commission of India has announced the schedule of General Election to Legislative Assemblies of Haryana and UT of Jammu & Kashmir, 2024, whereby, the poll in State of Haryana will be held on 05.10.2024 and counting will take place on 08.10.2024 respectively.

2. Further, in view of the statutory provisions under section 135C of the Representation of People Act, 1951 provides that no spirituous, fermented or Intoxication liquor or other substances of like nature shall be sold, given or distributed at a hotel, eating house, tavern, shop or any other place, public or private, within a polling area during the period of (48) forty eight hours ending with the hours fixed for the conclusion of poll for any election in that polling area. The Commission has also directed that the date on which Counting of Votes is to be taken up shall also be declared 'Dry Day'. This will include the date of re-poll, if any.

3. As per directions of the Election Commission of India steps shall also be taken to prohibit sale of liquor in adjoining areas of the concerned constituencies so that there are no chances of clandestine movement of liquor from those areas had the restriction not be in operation.

4. You are, therefore, requested to take necessary steps to prohibit sale of liquor and declare "Dry Day" for the above mentioned dates during 48 hours ending with the hours fixed for conclusion of poll as indicated in the Commission's notification with respect to polling day and on counting day in the adjoining areas with the State of Haryana in the radius of 3 KMS adhering the guidelines/instructions issued by Election Commission of India.



ORDER

Whereas, General Elections to Vidhan Sabha, 2024 of the State of Haryana is re-scheduled to be held on 05.10.2024 and counting of votes is scheduled to be held on 08.10.2024. Accordingly, the earlier order no. 1688/X-V, dated 30.08.2024 is superseded.

Whereas, no liquor shops, hotels, restaurants, clubs and other establishment's selling/serving liquor, shall be permitted to sell/serve liquor to anyone whatsoever on polling day and counting day.

Therefore, I, Ashok Kumar Meena, IAS, Excise Commissioner, Haryana, Panchkula in pursuance of the provisions of rule 37(10) of the Haryana Liquor License Rules, 1970 hereby order that the liquor vends located in the State of Haryana shall remain closed during the period of Forty Eight (48) hours ending with the hour fixed for the conclusion of poll and on the day of Counting i.e. 08.10.2024 till the counting is over.

I further order that the restriction prescribed in the excise laws on possession and storage of liquor in unlicensed premises shall be vigorously enforced in order to ensure that storage of liquor by individuals is drastically reduced during the aforementioned period.



Whereas, the General Election to Legislative Assemblies in the State of Haryana is scheduled on 05-10-2024 and UT of Jammu and Kashmir, 2024 is scheduled on 18-09-2024 and 01-10-2024 and Counting is scheduled to take place on 08th October, 2024.

And whereas, for the purpose of ensuring free, fair, peaceful and smooth elections, it has been directed by the Election Commission of India that States should declare "Dry Days" 48 hours before the close of polls and the counting day.

Now therefore, I, Dr. Yunus, Financial Commissioner (Excise)-cum-Commissioner of State Taxes and Excise, Himachal Pradesh in exercise of powers conferred under Section 5 (1) of the Himachal Pradesh Excise Act, 2011, rules framed there under and conditions No.1.2 and 8.1. of the Excise Announcements for the year 2024-25, hereby order that the following periods/days shall be observed as "Dry Days" within 3 Kilometers of the respective polling areas adjoining to the State of Haryana and UT of Jammu and Kashmir as under :-

Further, on all the days/periods/within the area (in kms) specified above, no spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors or other substances of like nature shall be sold/served, given or distributed at a hotel, eating house or tavern, shop or in other place (public or private) in Himachal Pradesh (Sirmaur, Revenue Distt. BBN, Baddi, Solan and Chamba). No liquor shop, hotel, restaurant, club and establishment selling/serving liquor, shall be permitted to sell/serve liquor to anyone on the aforesaid

etc. and Hotels run by anyone even if they are issued different categories of licenses for possession and supply of liquor, shall also not be permitted to serve liquor on these days/periods/within the area (in kms).

Further, the concerned Collector (Excise), Dy. Commissioner of State Taxes and Excise / Asstt. Commissioner of State Taxes and Excise Incharge of the respective District as well as the Jt. Commissioner of State Taxes and Excise (Flying Squad) are directed to implement this order scrupulously and ensure compliance by all licensees, their employees and all concerned within their respective jurisdiction and also make arrangements for extensive patrolling in the neighboring areas of their respective jurisdiction to ensure compliance.

Further, it is also made clear that concerned Addl./ Jt. Commissioner of State Taxes, Dy./Asstt. Commissioner of State Taxes and Excise, STEOs, ASTEOs and all other excise officers shall be responsible for any violation of Excise Laws within their respective jurisdictions. The matter be given top priority.

The Election Commission of India had announced the schedule for General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Jammu and Kashmir and Haryana vide Press Note No.ECI/PN/128/2024 dated 16th August, 2024 wherein the date of poll for J&K (Phase-3) and Haryana was fixed on 1st October, 2024 (Tuesday), date of Counting on 04.10.2024(Friday) and date of completion of election process on 06.10.2024 (Sunday).


2. Subsequently, representations have been received from National Political Parties, State Political Party and All India Bishnoi Mahasabha regarding mass movement of people of Bishnoi community of Haryana to Rajasthan to participate in centuries old Asoj Amavasya festival celebration. It may deny voting rights to large number of people and may lead to reduce voters' participation in general election to legislative assembly of Haryana.

3. The Commission, having considered these representations, has decided to change the date of poll **only for Haryana** from 1st October, 2024 (Tuesday) to **5th October, 2024 (Saturday)**.

conclusion of poll with respect to polling day for an election in that polling area where General Elections to Legislative Assembly are being held. This will include the date of re-poll, if any.

5. No liquor shops, hotels, restaurants, clubs and other establishments selling or serving liquor shall be permitted to sell/serve liquor to anyone whosoever, on the aforesaid days.
6. Non-proprietary clubs, star hotels, restaurants etc. and hotels functioning under different categories of licenses for possession and supply of liquor, shall not be permitted to serve liquor on these days.
7. The storage of liquor by individuals shall be curtailed during the above period and the restrictions provided in the excise law on the storage of liquor in unlicensed premises shall be vigorously enforced.
8. The Commission directs that the State/UT Government shall strictly implement the above measures and issue detailed and comprehensive instructions to all concerned authorities to take appropriate and legally effective measures to implement the above prohibitions and assist the election authorities in peaceful and smooth conduct of free and fair poll.



PRESS NOTE

Subject: General Election to Legislative Assemblies of Jammu & Kashmir and Haryana, 2024 - Change of Date of Poll in Haryana and Counting of Votes in Jammu and Kashmir and Haryana- regarding.

The Election Commission of India had announced the schedule for General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Jammu and Kashmir and Haryana vide Press Note No.ECI/PN/128/2024 dated 16th August, 2024 wherein the date of poll for J&K (Phase-3) and Haryana was fixed on 1st October, 2024 (Tuesday), date of Counting on 04.10.2024(Friday) and date of completion of election process on 06.10.2024 (Sunday).


2. Subsequently, representations have been received from National Political Parties, State Political Party and All India Bishnoi Mahasabha regarding mass movement of people of Bishnoi community of Haryana to Rajasthan to participate in centuries old Asoj Amavasya festival celebration. It may deny voting rights to large number of people and may lead to reduce voters' participation in general election to legislative assembly of Haryana.

3. The Commission, having considered these representations, has decided to change the date of poll **only for Haryana** from 1st October, 2024 (Tuesday) to **5th October, 2024 (Saturday)**.

4. The revised schedule for the General Election to Legislative Assembly of Haryana and Jammu and Kashmir (Phase-3), 2024 is as follows:

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited and to apprise that the
Commission has announced the General Elections to Legislative
Assemblies of Haryana and UT of Jammu and Kashmir, 2024 vide its
Press Note No. ECI/PN/128/2024 dated 16.08.2024, available on the
Commission's website under URL [https://www.eci.gov.in/issue-
details-page/press-releases](https://www.eci.gov.in/issue-
details-page/press-releases) The date of Poll for the said elections in UT
of Jammu and Kashmir has been fixed on 18.09.2024(Wednesday),
25.09.2024(Wednesday) and 01.10.2024(Tuesday) in three phases and
date of poll in Haryana is 01.10.2024(Tuesday). The date of counting
for said elections in both the Poll going State and UT has been fixed on
04.10.2024(Friday).

2. In this regard, your attention is invited to Section 135C of the
Representation of the People Act, 1951 which provides that no
spirrituous, fermented or intoxicating liquor or other substances of like
nature shall be sold, given or distributed at a hotel, eating house,
tavern, shop or any other place, public or private, within a polling area
during the period of forty-eight hours ending with the hour fixed for
the conclusion of poll for any election in the polling area.

3. In view of the statutory provision as above, 'Dry day' shall be
declared and notified under the relevant State/UT laws as is
appropriate during 48 hours, ending with the hours fixed for

conclusion of poll with respect to polling day for an election in that polling area where General Elections to Legislative Assembly are being held. This will include the date of re-poll, if any.

4. The Commission further directs that the date on which counting of votes is to be taken up i.e. 04.10.2024(Friday), shall also be declared 'Dry Day' under the relevant laws in poll going State/UT.

5. No liquor shops, hotels, restaurants, clubs and other establishments selling or serving liquor shall be permitted to sell/serve liquor to anyone whatsoever, on the aforesaid days.


6. Non-proprietary clubs, star hotels, restaurants etc. and hotels functioning under different categories of licenses for possession and supply of liquor, shall not be permitted to serve liquor on these days.

7. The storage of liquor by individuals shall be curtailed during the above period and the restrictions provided in the excise law on the storage of liquor in unlicensed premises shall be vigorously enforced.

8. The Commission directs that the State/UT Government shall strictly implement the above measures and issue detailed and comprehensive instructions to all concerned authorities to take appropriate and legally effective measures to implement the above prohibitions and assist the election authorities in peaceful and smooth conduct of free and fair poll.
